**RE: ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLAN**

The Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) "Asbestos-containing Materials in Schools" Regulation requires the identification and assessment of all asbestos-containing materials and the preparation of a Management Plan to protect building occupants from exposure to asbestos fibers. Wadsworth/ALERT Laboratories, Inc. performed a survey of the entire building to locate asbestos-containing materials in accordance with these EPA regulations.

In the course of the building survey conducted during June and July of 1988, some asbestos-containing building materials were found in remote areas of the building. Under normal circumstances it would be unlikely, or even difficult, to make contact with these structural materials which are a few pipe joint systems above ceilings and other out-of-reach areas.

In keeping with our desire to eliminate any potential exposure to asbestos fibers, we have established an "Operation Maintenance Plan" that will establish guidelines for maintaining or removal of asbestos materials. As with all schools in Ohio, we are striving to be in compliance with all EPA regulations. I might add, our "Management Plan" which has been submitted to the State of Ohio is available for public inspection.

As a follow-up to our recent detailed re-inspection, we would like to emphasize that we feel this building is a safe place to work or study. To ensure that we maintain a healthy environment, we have engaged the assistance of qualified professionals, accredited by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Department of Health.
