The Construction Craft Laborer (CCL) Apprenticeship Program is a 4,000 hour on-the-job (OJT) training program. In addition to on-the-job training, an apprentice is required to receive approximately 436 hours of classroom instruction during the apprenticeship. Apprentices will receive their classroom instruction at the Laborers' Local #310 Training Center in Cleveland, Ohio and at the Laborers' Training Center in Millwood, Ohio.

The Local No. 310 CCL performs a variety of tasks in the construction industry including but not limited to tending carpenters, brick masons and cement masons. The Local No. 310 CCL performs asbestos and hazardous waste abatement. The CCL operates equipment such as all-terrain material handlers, bobcat-type equipment and many attachments, hand-held and walk-behind concrete saws, lasers, compressed air tools and others. The work of a CCL is physically demanding and is often performed in extreme weather conditions. The CCL usually works as part of a team but must also be capable of working on his/her own initiative. The CCL must be fully aware of safety requirements in his/her work area, for his/her own protection and the safety of others.

***Basic Requirements For Applicants: 1) Must possess a High School Diploma or G.E.D. 2) Must be 18 years of age. 3) Must be physically capable of performing the work of the CCL***

Applicants will take a written test. Applicants scoring medium or higher on the test will then be called for an interview/evaluation. Applications will be available at Building Laborers' Local 310, 3250 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio on the ***1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of the Month from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.***

**A non-refundable application fee of \$35.00 is required.**
