Job Seeker FAQ'S

What age does a job seeker have to be to attend the Job Fair?

Attending the Job Fair is a great experience for all Job Seekers, but participating employers will be hiring mostly ages 15 and older.

Do job seekers need to have any experience or training?

Employers will be hiring for a variety of positions. Typically no experience is required for entry level positions. Will there be volunteer opportunities available at the Job Fair?

Yes, there may be both paid and volunteer opportunities available.

Do adults have to accompany student job seekers to the Job Fair?

It is not necessary for adults to accompany student job seekers. Parents and others who may drive students are welcome to attend the Job Fair as well in search of their own opportunities.

Should parents assist student job seekers with completing applications and speaking to employers?

It is not recommended for parents to assist students at the Job Fair or attend in place of their student. Career Specialists will be available to assist job seekers.

Can job seekers complete applications before arriving at the Job Fair?

Although the employment applications are not available prior to the Job Fair, we recommend job seekers bring the completed [General Application](#) to the Job Fair. Some employers will accept this application; others may require their own to be completed. Resumes, references, paper and pens should also be brought to the Job Fair.

How long will job seekers be at the Job Fair?

Most job seekers will spend approximately 1-2 hours at the Job Fair but they are welcome to attend all 3 hours.
