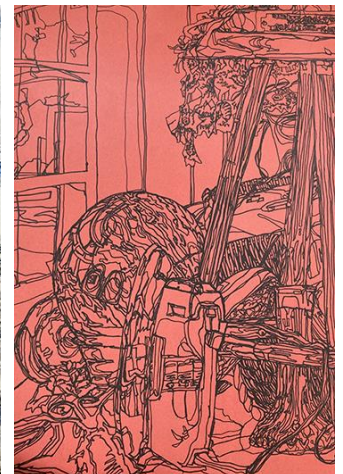
Career Readiness at Cuyahoga Heights High School

TechCred Program

The State of Ohio's TechCred program is now open through the end of January! TechCred is a statewide program that gives businesses an incentive to



upskill their current and potential employees. After identifying the technology-related skills needed, employers can partner with CVCC as their training provider for an industry-approved credential (hundreds have already been approved by the state, and they are accepting requests for new ones). Once proof of completion is attained for the short-term (less than one year), tech-related credential, the employer can be reimbursed up to \$2,000 per employee (up to \$30,000 total).
